

INFORMATION SHEET • PLEASE KEEP

This sheet is to help you more fully understand the new organizational points to registering your boat for placement on IBIC's boat rack.

First of all, you **must be a member** of the Indianola Beach Improvement Club in order to be eligible for using the boat rack. The membership term runs annually from January 1st to December 31st. So, at the beginning of the year you'll need to renew your membership. **Watch for a membership letter in the mail** each January with renewal information and forms or go to www.indianola.club and under THE CLUB heading you'll find JOIN OR RENEW which will also guide you in joining the IBIC.

The next step is to register your boat using the VESSEL REGISTRATION FORM. You will only need to fill out the registration form once as long as the information on the form has **not changed**. Ex: ownership information or the boat (new boat = new form).

DO NOT SEND IN THE \$30 FEE when you mail in the Vessel Registration Form. You will not be charged anything if your boat is not assigned a space on the boat rack. Assignment will be done in MARCH at a special meeting at the Indianola Clubhouse, to be announced.

At the March meeting, upon your arrival we will confirm that you are a current IBIC member and that you have registered your boat. If we need to have a lottery due to lack of space per number of boats registered we will draw for spaces. This is when you will need to pay the \$30 fee and upon payment you will receive a hull sticker with instruction sheet (both pictured at right). This will be a **permanent sticker** for your boat so adhere it to the boat you intend to place on the rack. If you change boats for any reason, there will be a replacement fee for a new sticker.

If you are unable to attend the meeting, we must have a current record of your IBIC membership and your Vessel Registration Form in hand to include you in space assignment. You may pay the fee and get your hull sticker by arrangement later. Also, if you are unable to attend the March assignment meeting and you are assigned a space, we must receive your \$30 fee by June 1st or your space will be reassigned to the next person on the assignment list.

Send your Vessel Registration Form in with your IBIC Membership Form if possible.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

Before applying your labels, follow these guidelines to ensure the best adhesion:

Clean the surface with alcohol or solvent* prior to application to ensure the surface is not contaminated. Injection molded and machined parts often have oil residue contaminates. Do not clean with soapy water or cleaners that leave residue. Oils from your hands can contaminate the adhesive on the label. ***Test solvents in an inconspicuous area before use.**

Use firm pressure when applying label to increase adhesive contact to the application surface. The adhesive is activated with pressure. To prevent air bubbles under the label, press down one edge of the label and move across the label applying firm pressure.

Warm temperatures will make the adhesive more pliable, and will increase surface contact when applying to textured surfaces. Adhesive cures quicker in warm environments. When extremely cold, the adhesive will have less initial tack and will take longer to cure. Manufacturer recommends the label and application surface to be between 70-90° F for optimal adhesion.

Give adhesive time to cure after applying. The pressure of applying the label begins a curing process. The adhesive will fully cure 1-2 weeks after the initial application.
